PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

The Del Valle Ducks have implemented the following Parent Code of Conduct for the important message it holds about the proper role of parents in supporting their child in sports. Parents should read, understand and sign this form prior to your child/children participating in our organization.

1. I will encourage members of both teams.
2. I will keep all comments positive. I will be a positive role model for my child and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators at every game, practice or other sporting event.
3. I will remember that the game is played for the youth and not for the adults.
4. I understand that only players and coaches are allowed on the field, no exceptions.
5. I will leave the coaching to the coaches. Know my role. **Athletes – Compete; Coaches – Coach; Officials – Officiate; Parents – Parent**
6. I understand criticizing the officials, coaches, opponents or fans will not be tolerated at all. Same goes for abusive language or cursing. This is youth sports, everyone makes mistakes.
7. I will be supportive. Creating unnecessary drama or stirring controversy is grounds for dismissal from the program.
8. I understand that playing time and positions are at the discretion of the coaches and is determined by what is best for the player and team. Football is a team sport and every position is off equal value.
9. I understand that there will be no open alcoholic beverages on the fields or parking areas.
10. I will help make this a positive and fun experience for all.
11. I will get involved.
12. I will conduct myself in a way that presents a positive image of the Del Valle Ducks and myself.

Policy Enforcement: Individuals will be given a warning for inappropriate activity and behavior. Individuals that continue will be asked to leave the fields. Other sanctions as deemed necessary by the president or board may be enforced.
