FAST FACTS:

All games are played in the rain... thunder and/or lightning will give cause to delay/cancel a game. This is up to the referee or club executive.

No jewelry of any kind is to be worn during play.

Arrive 15 minutes before your game time.

Parents: remember this is a game for all of our kids.... Try not to take it too seriously and have fun!!!

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS - RECREATIONAL LEAGUE ONLY

1. I have not heard from a Coach?

Coaches will be provided their rosters approx. the end of May. Practices officially start June 1. Each individual coach schedules will determine when you are notified. The coach to which your child is assigned will contact you and let you know when and where practices will be. If you have not heard from your coach by June 5th, please contact the League President.

2. What days and what time will practices be?

Each coach is a volunteer. Based on the coach's schedule, he/she will develop a schedule and notify you. However, the CSC schedules age appropriate times in the hopes that coaches can schedules practices and have scrimmages before the season starts.

3. Where will practices be?

Practice sessions will be at the Canfield Township Park on Herbert Road. This is the home of the CSC.

4. How do I become a coach?

Please visit the coaches tab on the website.

5. When and where are games?

Regular games are played weekday evenings (not Wednesdays) at 6:00 or 7:15 pm at the Township Park on Herbert Road.

6. Should my child play competitive or recreational?

Almost all competitive players start in the Recreational League and in fact, continue to play both until Age 13. If your child really loves soccer then the fall competitive league would be the next step. Please visit the Competitive tab on the website for more details.

7. Can I get my siblings on the same team?

If siblings fall into the same age bracket we will do our best to place them on the same team. Please contact the club registrar to confirm.

8. Can I request a particular coach?

Requests are not permitted. Every attempt is made to create the teams as balanced as possible to promote a positive, fun experience.

9. Can I change the team to which my child is assigned?

<u>This is very difficult</u>. When the teams were created, every attempt to balance the teams based on skills and years of experience were made. Changing teams can create teams that are unbalanced. Teams may be full and there is no room to add additional players to another team. Additionally, if practices have already started, the bonds that are created may create more problems.

10. What if I am having problems with the coach?

Please contact the League President. Refer to Problem Resolution Soccer Refund Policy at the website.

11. I don't live in Canfield. Can I still register my children?

Yes, Canfield Soccer Club Recreational League is open to surrounding communities.

12. How old does my child have to be to play soccer?

CSC regulations state that the player must be 5 years old by July 31st. Refer to U.S. Youth Soccer Registration ages – "What Age Group will my Child Play In" at the website.

13. Can my child play up or down a level?

Any child with advanced abilities has an option to play up a level. Please contact the League President to authorize this. Children are not able to play down a level.

14. Can I get a refund if my child does not play?

Refer to Refund Policy at the website.

15. What does my child need in order to play?

Your child will need black shorts, shin guards, outdoor soccer shoes (no metal spikes), water bottle and a size appropriate soccer ball. The Club will provide socks and team shirt.

16. Can I get my child on the same team as another child for car pooling reasons? We are not able accommodate this request.
