

Warren Park Youth Baseball Tee Ball League Rules

Revised 4/2008

1. Games are played at the times and locations shown on the schedule.
2. Each player must be in complete uniform, including mitt, in order to play.
3. No players may leave base until play forces them to the next base.
4. Each player bats once each inning. A half-inning is over after each player has batted once, whether or not three outs are made. Scores are not kept. The batted ball must go at least 15 feet or it is a foul ball. Coaches should inscribe a line in the dirt 15' from home plate.
5. If a batter reaches three strikes, the home-plate Coach/Parent should assist in hitting. Batters do not strike out.
6. Batters may advance only one base after hitting the ball in play.
7. Bases are 45' apart, pitcher's mound is 30' from home.
8. All players will play in the field. Coaches are allowed in the field with their team to help with defensive alignments and verbally direct the action. Coaches must not touch live balls.
9. Bats can be wood or metal. The barrel of the bat can not be more than 2-1/4" in diameter.
10. Home team coaches, assistants or parents set up the field prior to the start of the game, and return the equipment to the equipment box after the game. Both coaches must check that the equipment box is securely locked using both locks, before leaving the field.
11. All coaches must fill out a Chicago Park District Volunteer Application and return the completed application to the Board.
