- 8. Discussion and Consider Action on Staff and the organizational ramifications, organizational structure and succession planning Nick's Contract expires 6/30/2022 Boost Select Baseball when the county park opens
  - a. Melanie made a motion to retain Nick Gordon as a W-2 employee at his current DOC and Coach rate (\$95,400 annually) per the job description reviewed by Shiloh at the meeting. This includes eliminating the Boys & Girls DOC positions and transitioning Anna and Ivan to report to Scott. Jenn 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously.
  - b. Jason made a motion to create a new admin office position as a W2 employee at a rate not to exceed \$60,000 annually, reporting to Scott. This person will physically sit in the office. Melanie 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously.
  - c. Melanie 2<sup>nd</sup>. Passed unanimously.
  - d. The board discussed the need for a Sports Director for Baseball. While no vote was taken, Scott was tasked with working with baseball on a Job Description and establishing and interview team and to being sourcing candidates.
