

Whew! I've registered for Spring Soccer! Now what happens?

What's the Board doing?

Immediately after the last registration date, your Region Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, the uniforms will be ordered and the coaches will be notified.

When do the coaches get their teams?

Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters in mid February.

When do the players get called?

The coaches will call the players usually from mid to late February. They will give you all the information you will need in regards to team training times and location. Each coach sets his/her own day to train and time. Team training will be at Mallard Creek Community Park (3001 Johnston-Oehler Road).

It's late February and my child has not been called. What do I do?

Please do not panic if you see teams out on the field and your child has not been called. Not all teams begin training at the same time. The very young teams, in particular, do not always begin the same time as older teams. Also some coaches may be out of town. If your child has not been called by March 1st, please contact us at

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, socks) and supplemental accident insurance. Parents need to supply shin guards, soccer cleats, a soccer ball (size depends on age) and a water bottle.

How often are games and training?

Team training is held once a week (times to be determined by your child's coach). Games will be on Saturdays with the first game on March 8th. All training and games are held at Mallard Creek Community Park (3001 Johnston-Oehler Road).

Refund?

AYSO Region 605 incurs several non-refundable fees during your registration process. And, as a non-profit we recoup these costs from the registration fee we collect from you. As a result, if a refund is requested, the Region will refund your registration fee less twenty-five dollars (\$25.00). After the first game of the fall season, no refunds will be issued.

Player(s) attempting to register after the deadline will be placed on a Standby/Wait List.
