

Minutes AYSO Meeting: 02/18/20015, 7:00pm to 9:00pm, Millbrae Recreation Center

Old Business

- Steve Chin got the AYSO banner printed
- RCA report from Lou Skyriotis : 100% of Millbrae coaches were Safe Heaven, 90% officially certified for their age group.
- Winter season report from Dominique Foy:
3 U8 Girls teams, 1 U8 Boy team and 1 U9 Boy team participated to Winter Futsal league 2014 at Burlingamer. The experience successfully tested interest level among Millbrae families for winter soccer at U8 division level. Next step: explore possibility to create a formal AYSO Winter program for U8 in winter 2015.

Spring season

- 4 teams: 2 x U14, 1 x U16, and 1 x U8 playing in Foster City
- No uniforms will be provided by AYSO Millbrae to any team playing in Spring Leagues or tournament.
- Registration process managed by coaches directly with their team
- 1 field to line at Taylor for U14 games on Sundays

- Field availability for practices:
 - o Taylor: Monday and Wednesday from 5pm to 9pm
 - o Spring Valley: Tuesday and Thursday from 4:15pm until dark

Fall season preparation

- Finance: need budget draft from John in order to determine fees increase. City has informed they will raise the field usage fees.
- Marketing:
 - o Lawn signs: remind everyone it can be only installed in private residence with agreement from the owner
 - o Need to order fridge magnets and postcards
- Management:
 - o Need to recruit an assistant Registrar to eventually become new Registrar.
 - o Regional coach trainer: Steve Chin
- Promotion: AYSO Millbrae will be donating 6 gift certificates for free Fall registration to each of the Millbrae school PTA fund raising events (1 certificate for each Elementary school and 2 certificates for Taylor Middle School)
