

AYSO REGION 304 FIELD MONITOR DUTIES

Thank you for assisting Region 304 as a field monitor. Your basic duties as a Field Monitor are to serve as the eyes and ears of the Region on the playing fields. Please assist us by performing the following:

- Check out a hand-held radio and become familiar with its operation;
- Wear the orange field monitor vest provided to you;
- Become familiar with the field numbers, refer to the map provided;
- Patrol the fields (all areas) and contact the field table via radio, if you observe visitors violating the following rules:
 - NO DOGS ALLOWED
 - NO SMOKING ON SCHOOL PREMISES
 - NO OUTSIDE CART VENDORS (ICE CREAM/CORN ETC.)
- Also, please assist us in reporting the following:
 - Overflowing trash
 - Accidents involving players or spectators that may require medical attention.
 - Unsporting behavior by players or, coaches, or spectators that may require intervention by Region 304 staff.
 - Dangerous conditions, such as holes on the field.
 - Requests by referees to contact the Referee Tent or Field Tent for assistance.

If you observe any of the situations, contact the Field Tent immediately. DO NOT attempt to intervene in a conflict or medical emergency unless requested to do so by Region Staff.
