Grafton Girls Softball **2015 Pitching Academy**

The Pitching Academy is a series of 30 minute lessons offered on a weekly basis from November thru March. The sessions will be conducted on Tuesday evenings at the South Grafton Elementary School gym.

We are very happy to introduce Toni (Hileman) Cassella as our new pitching instructor. As a high school pitcher, Toni was a 2 time All-Ohio selection and had 12 career no-hitters. After a record setting freshman season at Ohio University, Toni transferred to Ohio State University where she was the Buckeye's pitcher of the year in 1999.

This year we have also added Leah Allen as our junior instructor. Leah is a pitcher for Grafton High school and a standout tournament pitcher. Leah is a product of the Pitching Academy and a Grafton Diamond alumna who helped the Diamonds win the 2011 Mass ASA12B State Championship.

The Academy is open to any player who is willing to make a major commitment to becoming a better pitcher. In addition to the weekly sessions, players are expected to practice their lessons between sessions. Since parents often serve as catcher for their daughter, parents have to be prepared to "get out there" every day too. (Note: Players must provide their own catcher; instructors are not able to serve as catchers.)

The Academy offers two different programs:

Private – Private lessons offer the opportunity for pitchers to work one-on-one with an instructor. The cost for private sessions is \$450 for 17 thirty-minute lessons (\$225 with junior instructor).

Semi-Private – Instructors will work with 2 pitchers at the same time in our semi-private format. Since there are only 2 pitchers per group, there is plenty of personal instruction during these sessions. The cost for semi-private lessons is just \$300 for the 17 weeks (\$150 with junior instructor).
