

## CHESTERFIELD LITTLE LEAGUE Pitch Count Procedure

To properly monitor the pitch count rule enacted by Little League, Chesterfield Little League adopts the following policy:

- 1. Each team will be provided regular season pitch count record forms.
- 2. The home team will be responsible for providing a volunteer (outside of manager/coaches) to keep the official pitch count records for both teams. The team scorekeeper shall not keep the pitch count also. Managers are still responsible for being aware of the individual pitch counts for their pitchers.
- 3. Each team should verify the official pitch count at the end of each half inning.
- 4. No appeals may be issued unless the managers' pitch count varies from the official pitch count by more than three pitches.
- 5. Upon the completion of the game, the official pitch count record shall be signed by each manager. The home team shall record the pitch count for each pitcher on both teams in the database within 24 hours of game start time.
- 6. Managers must retain their copies of all pitch count logs and produce if needed. Failure to pitch count log would result in pitcher
