Nā Hoa o Puna Parental Code of Conduct

As parents, we must always strive to lead by example. As members of the Nā Hoa o Puna 'ohana, we agree to do the following:

- Be respectful and courteous to referees, linesmen, coaches, players, other parents and fans. This means that I will not taunt, ridicule, yell, or argue with these entities.
- Think of the welfare of the team and club as a whole, not only that of my own child.
- Encourage good habits such as commitment, respect, safety, and perseverance in my child by making sure:

-My child attends practice regularly. If for some reason he/she cannot attend, I will contact the team parent and/or coach to let them know ahead of time.

-My child is in good academic standing throughout the season. Should their grades fall behind, I will inform the team parent and/or coach immediately.

-My child abides by any disciplinary action or rules set forth by the coach.

-My child shows up to trainings and games with the required equipment (including shinguards, socks, and the right attitude.

- Speak **directly** with the coach regarding concerns with officiating, coaching, etc. at an **appropriate** time (after games or after practice, not during).

•Remove myself from situations in which I am unable to make sound decisions and abide by the above guidelines.

•We understand that game jerseys are on loan to the player and that they need to be returned before leaving the field after every game. Should the game jersey be misplaced or marred, we agree to cover the entire cost to replace it.

Nā Hoa means *friends*, and I understand that our club's goal is to maintain a friendly 'ohana environment that supports good, competitive soccer.

As a member of Nā Hoa o Puna, I will also ensure that supporters who attend games and practices on my child's/family's behalf will be respectful and abide by our club's code of conduct also.

By signing below, I acknowledge that I have read, understand, and agree to comply with the above statements. I understand that failure to comply may lead to disciplinary actions including my family's dismissal from the club.
