## **Kernersville Little League - General Rules and Guidelines**

These rules are not to be construed to be all-inclusive, but should be viewed as a guide for situations that may occur. These rules apply equally to everyone while on league property. Violation of these rules may result in suspension from the Swaim Complex.

## FIREARMS OR ANY WEAPONS ARE PROHIBITED AT ALL LITTLE LEAGUE FACILITIES

The use or possession of any alcoholic beverages or illegal drugs is strictly prohibited. This shall include all occasions while engaged in Little League activities regardless of location. Violation will result in an automatic one-year suspension from all activities involving the Kernersville Little League.

Glass or metal containers (except those associated with the normal operation of the facility) are prohibited due to safety, littering, and equipment damage concerns.

Everyone is responsible for ensuring that all debris is placed in the containers provided.

Property abuse will not be tolerated. This shall include all team equipment and facilities.

Careless and reckless driving is strictly prohibited. There shall be no parking near the entrance gate to the complex. Vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. The Swaim Complex Speed Limit is 10 MPH.

Horseplay is prohibited. This is to include sliding on handrails, fighting and sliding down hills.

Warm up activities are prohibited in the vicinity of the concessions/administration building due to potential personal injury and property damage.

Batting or throwing against backstops or fences is prohibited. Climbing over or on fences, soft-toss screens, batting cages or backstops is prohibited due to safety considerations. Anyone observed abusing the assets of the facility will be suspended from the complex for the remainder of the day.

Both teams shall pick up all trash and debris on and around the field AFTER EACH GAME! The home team is responsible for raking around the pitchers mound and home plate area after a game. The visiting team will be responsible for the infield dirt.

Verbal abuse or threatening language directed toward anyone will not be tolerated, and may result in suspension or termination of membership.

Parents/guardians shall supervise non-participating children at all times.

All riding toys, including bicycles, four wheelers, trail bikes, skateboards, and roller blades are prohibited.

Pets are prohibited at the Swaim Sports Complex or Sahabi

Any player under a doctor's care for injury must present a medical release from their doctor to their Respective V.P. before they may participate in games or practices.

Kernersville Little League is not responsible for personal injury, or damage to any motor vehicle while on league property.

There will be no pick-up games played on empty fields after the lights are required to be turned on for play to continue on adjacent fields.

In order to operate field equipment (i.e. tractor, trap rake, twister, etc.) you must be a licensed driver or have a NC operators permit.

Any manager, coach, parent, or spectator ejected from a game by an umpire or League Official shall immediately leave the complex. If the ejected party has a child participating, he/she shall remain, without additional disruptions, at their vehicle until their child finishes play. Any player ejected must leave the complex with their parent/guardian. If no parent/guardian is present, the ejected player must be escorted to the concession stand and remain with an adult to await the arrival of a parent/guardian. Anyone ejected must leave for the day, and will not be permitted to enter the complex during the next scheduled game. A second offense during the season will result in a one week suspension. An additional offense will result suspension for the remainder of the season, including tournament and All-Stars.
