Coaches:

- C. Will be a good role model for the players and parents at all times.
- D. Should be **positive and constructive** while instructing players at practice and games.
- E. Should always be **consistent** with **players and parents**.
- F. Must **demonstrate and teach: Respect** for Referees, Opponents, Fellow Coaches, Teammates, Spectators, and the game.
- G. Will demonstrate and enforce fair play in regards to **integrity, fairness, and respect for all** involved in the game.
- H. Will promote **cooperation and sportsmanship** with the players, league, and the Soccer Association.
- Will communicate with players and parents in a respectful and dignified fashion. Disrespect or <u>the use of foul language will not be tolerated.</u>
- J. Coaches will be responsible to attend discipline hearings when required and accept decisions made at these hearings. Any decision made by The Board regarding discipline will be final.
