Team Parent Code of Conduct

As a Team Parent, I understand:

- The CYFC Board will run a background check prior to August 1st each year.
- A safe playing environment is free of drugs, alcohol, tobacco and profanity. I will refrain from their use at all youth football practices, games and events.
- Any parent concerns or complaints (that cannot be reasonably resolved) should be shared with the appropriate CYFC Player Representative, Vice President or President.
- A reasonable level of confidentiality of players' information should be maintained.
- I represent CYFC so I will be a positive role model, always remaining respectful.
- My responsibilities may include:
 - Assisting the Registration Coordinator by collecting outstanding documents, compiling and organizing them into the team book.
 - Handling team communications regarding practice/game/event schedules and locations under the direction of the Head Coach.
 - Assisting the Fundraising Coordinator with distributing, tracking and/or collecting fundraising materials and/or funds for my team.
 - Creating a half-time snack sign-up or schedule and reminding parents when it is their turn.
 - Assisting the Registration Coordinator with recruiting volunteers for home games and assisting Coaches with recruiting volunteers for the chains during away games.
 - Assisting with the distribution of equipment and/or gear.

**I further understand that my failure to abide by this code of conduct may result in the suspension or termination of my rights to participate as a team parent for Cromwell Youth Football & Cheer Program.
