MSI Board of Director's Executive Committee meeting was held at the MSI offices. Chairman Ertel called the meeting to order at 7:45 pm, with the following Executive Committee members and staff in attendance: Ertel, Prill, Coflin, Reed, and Schuessler.

The following agenda items were completed at the Executive Committee meeting:

## 1. Administrative.

- a. Committee members met with candidate for MSYSA president. Detailed discussion on the core issues from MSI Board's perspective was held with the candidate.
- b. Appeal heard by Executive committee members concerning refund of fees for travel team expenses. Board President will send official decision on the appeal.
- c. 2nd appeal heard concerning game forfeiture for MSI Classic team. Numerous e-mails provided as background. Official decision on appeal will be sent to team coach.
- 2. It was established that a quorum was present for the meeting.
  - *a. Review of prior meeting.* The December 2010 Executive Committee meeting minutes were approved.
- **3. Treasurer's Report.** The Treasurer's Report and balance sheet (dated April 26, 2011) were reviewed.

## 4. Spring Program Update.

- *a. Cherry Blossom tournament.* Overall tournament was very successful with a total of 230 teams participating. Soccerplex and MSI partnered very well with positive feedback received from many teams.
- *b.* Spring 2011 season. Rain has impacted each weekend of play this season. 100% of all games have been rescheduled, but additional rainouts will be problematic with limited field availability for remaining dates.

## 5. Fall Registration Fees (Recreation and Classic)

- *a. Recreation fees.* Proposal for 2011-2012 recreation fee of \$83 (Fall) and \$70 (Spring) = \$153 Total (1.3% increase from 2010-2011 rates). Approved by acclamation.
- *b. Recreation Refunds.* MSI staff will reexamine its refund policy and examine potential prorated refund amounts based on set withdrawal dates.
- *c. Classic fees.* Proposal for 2011-2012 classic fee to not exceed 2% increase from 2010-2011 fees. Approved by acclamation.
  [MSI Staff will present to Board the exact 2011-2012 Classic fees upon final financial calculations but it will not exceed 2% increase.]

6. Manna Food Drive – Spring Food drive is this weekend April 30 & May 1; additional Board members needed for volunteer efforts on those days.

## 7. Field Development

- a. MSI staff continues to pursue various Field Development efforts.
- 8. Other Business
  - a. Gudelsky Scholarship application will be posted his week with all applications due by May 20, 2011. Awardees will be announced in June 2011.
