The person receiving this award tonight has touched so many lives. I would like to give you all a small view of what this kind, generous, loving and respected person has done to be recognized by his peers in the community.

- Hailey Palmer was a young soccer player. Her motto was "Footprints in history aren't made sitting down." Her coach helped her live her mantra out even after her early death at the age of 12. He created a soccer tournament in her honor raising thousands of dollars to be given toward the Cystic Fibrosis Foundation and bringing in hundreds of teams to allow her legacy to live on. Still today this benefit tournament is helping Foundations each year help their communities.
- His heart for children facing hard circumstances continues to go on as he now coaches Bella. Bella
 was diagnosed with Ewing's Sarcoma (a type of bone cancer) in December 2013. She was

 with that goal by coaching her, helping her find the humor in the hard days, and keeping her huge
 competitive spirit alive.
