

## LAW XVII – CORNER KICK

1. When the ball passes completely over the defending team's goal-line, and was last touched by a defending player, and a goal was not scored, it shall be put into play by a kick taken:
  - A. by a player of the attacking team,
  - B. from the corner of the field nearest to where the ball crossed the goal line.
2. The ball must be placed on or within the Corner Arc.
3. The corner-flag may not be moved by a player for the taking of the corner kick.
4. A goal may be scored directly from a corner kick.
5. Defending players must remain 10 yards from the ball until it has been kicked.
6. If the player taking the corner kick touches the ball a second time before it has been touched by another player an INDIRECT free kick shall be awarded to the opposing team at the point of the offense. The kick will be taken from the place where the second touch occurred.
7. The Offside Law does not apply at the taking of a corner kick.
