

Special Needs Policy

Canfield Soccer Club (CSC) is comprised of volunteer Board Members, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Team Managers, all of whom may or may not be trained to handle children with either special physical or mental developmental requirements. It is the sole responsibility of the parent or guardian registering any such child to inform the CSC of any special requirements at the time of registration. CSC is dedicated to providing a safe environment in which children can learn and enjoy the game of soccer. All reasonable efforts will be extended to make sure that all children enjoy the CSC soccer program equally. Board Members, Coaches, Assistant Coaches and Team Managers, due to time and resource constraints, may not be able to adequately supervise children with either special physical or mental developmental requirements. In such a case, parents of such children may be required to directly assist in the supervision of their children.

CSC reserves the right to remove any child from the program, whether developmentally challenged or not, when by majority rule of the Board it has been determined that the child poses a threat to the physical safety and well being of the other participants within the CSC program.
