Issues/Complaints

- Complaints received regarding use of youth referees at State Tournament.
- Complaint received regarding officiating at State Tournament.
 - o Opinion was that State Tournament is special and best officials should be used.
 - o Complaints were not from Area 5C.
 - o Reality no inexperienced referees were used as Center Referee
 - A youth referee centered the U10B Championship game, but referee had centered many games for AYSO and Club.

Improvements

- Produce tournament schedules earlier in the week of the tournament.
- Clearly define any penalties for violating tournament rules.
- Rule changes should be determined and published early.
- Additional volunteers for tournaments at multiple venues (such as Dublin & Palmer parks).
- Clearly set team expectations regarding use of youth referees
- Clearly define penalties of team for any fan harassment of youth referees.
- Consider requiring the Center Referee of all championship games be an adult.
- Open to suggestions on ways to improve the tournaments.


