# Tournament Information

- 75% rule for playing time.
  - Before any player plays 100% of the game, all players must play 75% of the game.
  - All players required to play 50% of game.
- Round robin games will be reduced in length this weekend.
- 1<sup>st</sup> / 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> / 4<sup>th</sup> Place games on Sunday are full length and must have a winner
- Ensure your teams are at field 20 minutes prior to the game. Teams will be checked at field by referee.

# Tie Breakers

## Pool Play/Round Robin

1. Points total
2. Head-to-head competition.
3. Most number of wins
4. Goals allowed – total (up to a maximum of three per game; fewest number advances)
5. Goal differential – (up to three per game, most advances).
6. Kicks from the penalty mark



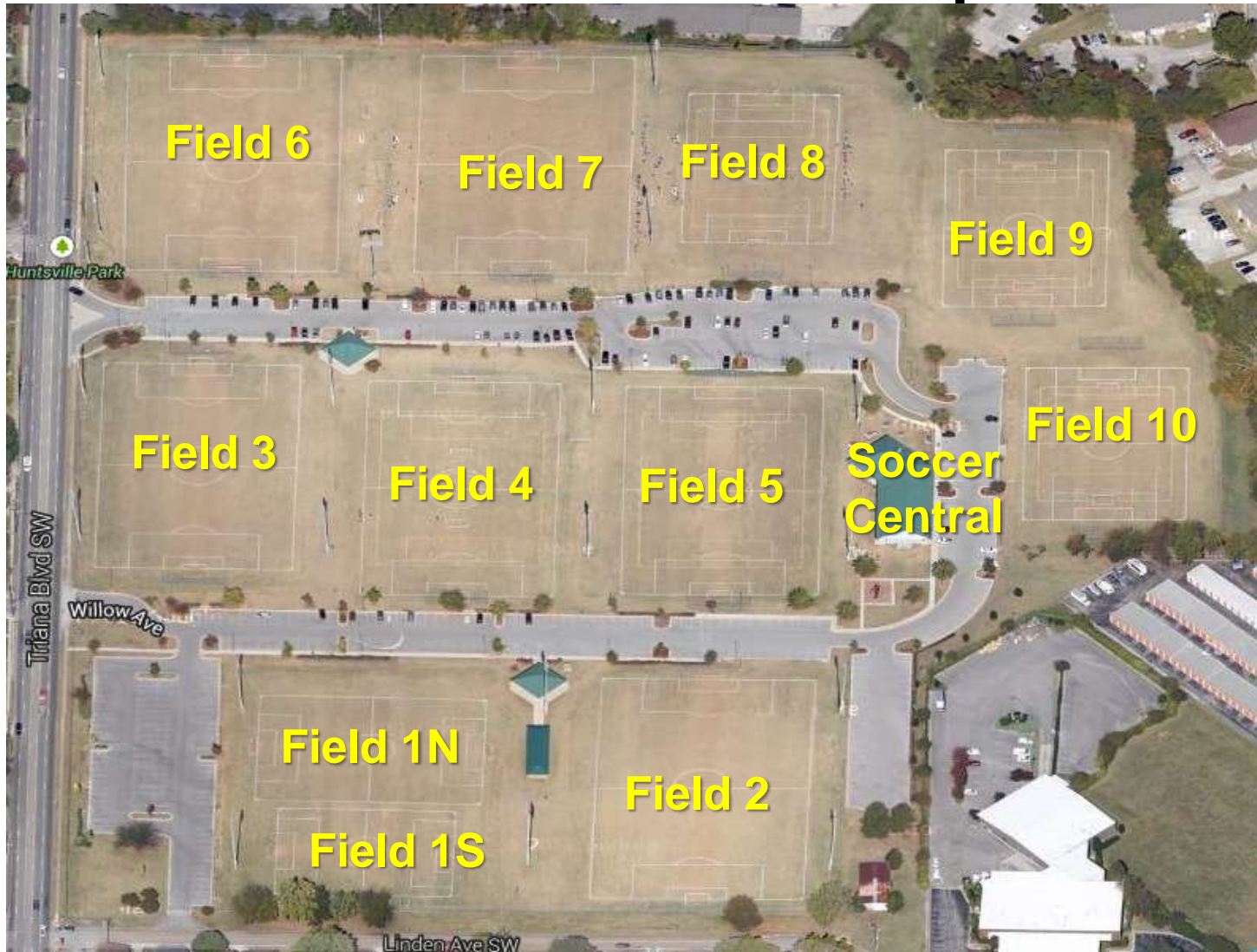
# Sportsmanship

- The best you can do is a win with 3 goals.
  - If you are ahead by five or more start pulling in your team
  - You do not have to allow the other team to score, just pull in your team
  - No shutout points
- Shake hands with the other team after game
- Coaches sign the game cards & match reports

# Referee Uniform

- Proper Referee Jersey (short or long sleeve)
- Jersey tucked in
- Black shorts
- Black socks with three white stripes pulled up
- Proper AYSO badge
- Black shoes
- Other jersey colors OK (officials must match)





# Referee Information

- Ensure You Report to Check-In Prior to Start of Games
- Roll call players from Roster during player inspection
- Noise-makers, air horns, etc. – Law 5



# Referee Information (cont)

- Youth Referees
  - Zero tolerance for harassment
  - Must have an authoritatively capable adult at game

- Fields will Have
  - Balls
  - Pennies \*check-in area
  - First Aid Kit
  - Ball Pump \*check-in area
- Bring your own flags
- Enjoy Meeting Referees from Other Regions



# Referee Information (cont)

- Start Games on Time. Sunset on Saturday is at 5:52 PM.
- No waiting for teams, forfeit if they are late (forfeits must be verified with T. D.)
- Finish the game on time.
- Time Change is Saturday Night.
- Sunset on Sunday is at 4:51 PM.



# Referee Information (cont)

- Regular rules on player equipment
- Eye glasses and knee braces are OK
- Splints/Casts are an absolute NO NO
- Cold weather, check the rules, jersey must be showing
- No guest players



# Referee Information (cont)

- Fun, Fair, Safe
- Avoid trifling stoppages
- What you don't call you encourage
- Referee has the whistle, don't argue
- No coaching from the spectators
- Area staff will not overrule the referee
- Alabama Code - Section 13A-11-144
  - Harassment of a sports official is a Class B misdemeanor



# Referee Information (cont)

- Coach Sendoff – Minus 3 Points
- Player Sendoff – Minus 2 Point
- Player Caution – No Points
- Sendoff's carry over to the State Tournament

- Self assign most games using Sportacus
- ARA reserves the right to reassign as needed
- Changes in games status, location, time, etc. will be emailed and texted automatically (if enabled in your profile settings)
