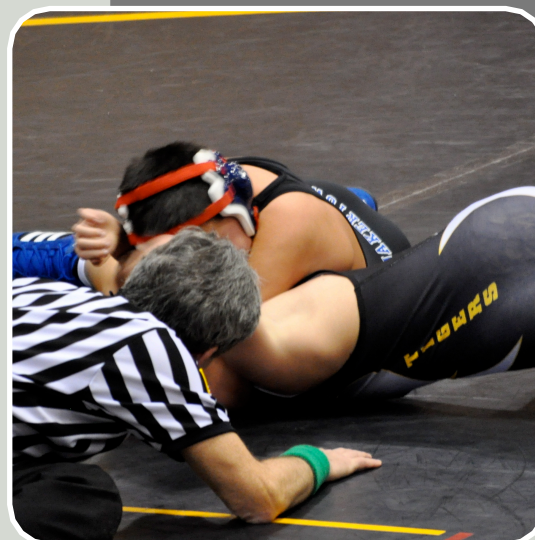
support their teammates during the Varsity and JV matches.
