COACH / PARENT / PLAYER - CODE OF CONDUCT

By signing the Sign-Up Form, we acknowledge that we have read and understand the following Joelton Community Club - Code of Conduct that applies to us, our family members or any one else that may be in attendance to watch our players at all games, tournaments, and practices. We agree to abide by the terms of this Code of Conduct and understand that breach of our agreement may result in our removal from a game(s) and banishment from park property. Punishment for code of conduct violations is governed by Joelton Community Club by-laws.

ALL PARTICIPANTS

1. No person will threaten, attempt or engage in violent acts.
2. No person shall use profanities, vulgarities or obscenities directed towards any umpires, coaches, players, parents or spectators.
3. No person will exhibit poor sportsmanship.
4. No person shall possess or be under the influence of any alcoholic beverages and/or drugs.
5. No person shall throw any debris on the playing field.
6. No person shall enter the area of play unless they are an appropriate/approved participant.
7. No person shall smoke outside designated areas.

COACHES

1. Will place the emotional and physical well being of any child ahead of personal desire to win.
2. Will insist that all children play in a safe and healthy environment.
3. Will train their child to treat other players, coaches, fans, and officials with respect and sportsmanship regardless of race, sex, creed or ability.
4. Will conduct themselves with honor and dignity while recognizing they are role model examples for all children and adults.
5. Will accept the decisions of the coaches, referees and representatives without arguments or derogatory comments or intimidating tactics.
6. Will only use positive encouragement to either team.

******Any person that physically threatens or assaults a coach, referee, player, sponsor, representative or spectator in a physical or verbal manner shall not be allowed to attend any games for the remainder of the season including the tournament. ZERO TOLERANCE will be observed.***
