- 1. Be encouraging, supportive and positive in regard to my child's play on the field.
- 2. Respect referees and accept their decisions.
- 3. Support the coach/s and players of the team at all times.
- 4. Demand a sports environment that is free from drugs, alcohol and tobacco and will refrain from their use at all games, exhibitions, practices and events.
- 5. Volunteer my services and talents to the MYSA whenever possible.
- 6. Familiarize myself with the laws of the game as posted on the league website and information board that is displayed at the field during game time.
- 7. Comply with the rules, policies and procedures of MYSA as they apply to me.
- 8. Discuss issues concerning my child:
 - Only with the coach.
 - Not with any other parent.
 - Only at a time mutually agreed upon with the coach.

As a parent of an MYSA soccer player, I will never:

- 1. Engage in harassment directed toward a referee.
- 2. Engage in any kind or type of unsportsmanlike conduct with any league official, referee, coach, player or parent.
- 3. Use drugs or alcohol at any practice, game or related sporting event.
- 4. Interfere at any time with the duties and responsibilities of the coach, referee or any other league official.
- 5. Act in any manner which is detrimental to the team or MYSA.
- 6. I acknowledge these rules apply to all spectators including any that may be present either with me or on my behalf and I will ensure that all abide by these guidelines.
- 7. I acknowledge that this Code of Conduct has been adopted by MYSA and agree that if I fail to abide by the aforementioned rules and guidelines, I will be subject to disciplinary action by MYSA that could include, but is not limited to the following:
 - Warning
 - Probation
 - Temporary suspension from attending games
 - Permanent suspension from attending games

In the event a situation arises which calls for interpretation, MYSA will take into account the best interest of each athlete, the entire team, the MYSA, and the integrity of the game of soccer. MYSA board decision, is accepted, and will be final.
