



## Jackson Little League is a zero tolerance league.

Please read, understand and abide by the following rules. This is in effect to insure a safe and rewarding experience for all involved.

- 1. Managers for each team are responsible for everyone involved with their team. This includes Players, Coaches and Spectators. Please be sure to explain the zero tolerance policy to all involved before the season starts. We also suggest assigning a responsible Parent to be your eyes outside the field and keep the other Spectators in line.
- 2. Proper respect is to be shown to everyone who is at the game. This includes Umpires, Managers, Coaches, Players, Board Members or Spectators. You are expected to treat others as you wish to be treated. A simple rule that goes a long way.
- 3. Any Player, Manager, Coach or Spectator can be removed from a game at any time by an Umpire or any Board member. The exception to this rule is if the Board member is an opposing Coach or Manager in the game.
- 4. Any Judgment calls by an Umpire are final and indisputable. This includes Balls/Strikes, Safe/Out, Fair/Foul and any other situation where a judgment is made.
- 5. Only a Manager may engage an Umpire, not a Coach, Player or Spectator. An Umpire has the ability to eject any other party who engages him.
- 6. There is no arguing with Umpires or opposing teams permitted at any time. In the event of a rule question, it is the Manager's responsibility to know the rules and provide proper documentation as proof and present the proof in a civil and professional manor. It is not an Umpire's responsibility to provide the proof of the rule in question.
- 7. Anyone ejected from a game will serve a minimum of a 1 game suspension. This includes Spectators as well as Players, Managers and Coaches. Penalties can be more than 1 game at the discretion of the Board, based on the severity of the problem. 1 game is the minimum.
- 8. All parties ejected from a game will have to appear before the Board before being allowed back to any JLL field.
- 9. Second occurrences by any party will result in suspension for the remainder of the season.
