

LTYA Response Guideline to Positive COVID-19 Test or Close Contact

Step 1: Reporting

Parents, players, coaches, officials, spectators, and staff members should report to LTYA if any of the following occur:

- A positive COVID-19 test
- Any known direct contact within your immediate family to someone who has tested positive for COVID 19.
- If you or anyone in your family have or plan to be tested for COVID 19 due to a suspected exposure.

Notification may be sent to your team coach, <u>scott@tylas.net</u> or the designated Covid-19 sport lead will respond as quickly as possible to collect relevant information. Questions about policies and procedures may also be sent to the same email address.

Step 2: Communication

LTYA will promptly notify families of players who have recently been in physical proximity to the affected individual, using the published practice, game and training schedules. LTYA will keep confidential (to every extent possible) the identity and health status of any affected individuals unless such individuals approve otherwise.

Step 3: Action

LTYA will take steps to limit further exposure of club members to the spread of illness. Actions may include suspension of practices/games/trainings for the affected individual, team or teams, sport division or even the entire sport. Where appropriate, LTYA will endeavor to consult with public health professionals to inform these decisions and will cooperate with state and local public health authorities as requested.
