## MAJORS DIVISION RULES

$>$ Official LL Regulations and Playing Rules will be followed, exceptions noted below.
$>$ Discuss any exception rules with the umpires before each game.

- Player Substitution - Rotate players evenly, each player sits one inning before any player sits a second inning.
- Playoffs - Use "MTLL Additional Playoff Rules" regarding substitution during playoffs.
- Batting -Every player is in the lineup and bats.
- Pitching - 85 Max pitches in a game ( 65 max until May 1, 75 max until June 1)
- 66-85 pitches $=4$ days rest
- 51-65 pitches $=3$ days rest
- 36-50 pitches $=2$ days rest
- 21-35 pitches $=1$ day rest
- 1-20 pitches = can pitch on consecutive days;
- If a pitcher hits $\mathbf{3}$ batters in an inning or 3 in a game, the pitcher must be removed.
- No intentional walks.
- A removed pitcher cannot pitch again in the same game.
- If a pitcher reaches a day(s) of rest threshold while facing a batter, the pitcher may continue to pitch until any one of the following conditions occurs: 1. That batter reaches base; 2. That batter is retired; 3 . The third out is made to complete the half-inning
- Pitch counts do NOT include warm-up tosses, practice pitches or throws to any base
- Pitch counts DO include pitches that hit the batter, are fouled off, or hit into field of play
- Stoppage of Plan - Play stops when the pitcher is on the Pitching Rubber. If runners are advancing they can continue.
- Catching - Players cannot catch after pitching 41 or more pitches in the same game (or day). Catchers can only pitch if they caught a maximum of 3 innings. If a catcher pitches less than 41 pitches, then they can return to catcher.
- Bunting - is allowed.
- Dropped 3 ${ }^{\text {rd }}$ Strike - the third strike called by the umpire is not caught, providing (1) first base is unoccupied or (2) first base is occupied with two out (NOTE: A batter forfeits his/her opportunity to advance to first base when he/she enters the dugout or other dead ball area)
- Stealing is allowed to any base, including home.
- Stealing $2^{\text {nd }}$ is only allowed on a pitch, batter cannot advance past first when walked.
- Run Maximum - 5 runs per inning, except for the $\mathbf{6}^{\text {th }}$ inning, which is unlimited. No other inning regardless of when the game is going to end will be the unlimited inning. Only $6^{\text {th }}$ inning.
- There is No 10-run rule.

> Any changes to Division Rules shall be unanimously agreed to by the managers of that division and the Chief of Umpires. The executive Committee shall review in the event of a conflict of interest. Any change shall be established with a start day provided to all managers, Chief of Umpire, and President. No rule changes will be permitted after the start of the playoff season.
