I am pleased to inform you that your application to the 7v7 has been approved.

Frederick County Maryland has implemented the following return to play protocol, which the league will adhere.



When a player or coach attends a game their presence affirms;

- a. They feel well, and are in good and free of COVID-19 symptoms;
- b. They do not have a fever;
- c. They have not been exposed to anyone who has the virus.
- Be respectful of Physical Distancing monitors if asked about spacing issues.
- Staff and athletes (when not participating) consistent with Maryland Strong Roadmap to Recovery Guidance should wear face Coverings.
- Players should go to the bathroom prior to arriving at the venue, there is not guarantee bathroom facilities will be available.
- The league will provide hand-sanitizing opportunities along with water breaks.
- One coach and 10 participants for each team are allowed on the field.
- Team huddles and high fives and hand shakes are suspending during participation
- Exit and Entry points should be on opposite sides of the field to prevent any accidental crossover between groups.
- The turn over time between games will be 10 minutes allow for groups to egress completely before the next scheduled group's arrival.
- Non-participant attendance should be kept minimal (family only) or nonexistent. Attendance must be consistent with Maryland Strong Roadmap to Recovery Guidance.
- Those in the "at risk" categories, including those age 60+, should consider not attending.
- All equipment should be sanitized before each game.
