Managing in Little League Baseball is a very generous contribution to the community, the league, and the game of baseball as well as a tremendous responsibility. We appreciate your interest in making this contribution and your willingness to undertake this responsibility.

McIntire Little League Majors teams play 16 regular season games with an average of two games per week. In addition to the games, most Majors managers practice an additional two days per week during the regular season and potentially more frequently before the games begin. Managing a Majors team is a significant time commitment. By submitting this application, you are confirming your commitment to this schedule.

McIntire Little League is governed by Little League International. There are many rules in Little League that all Managers must familiarize themselves with before the season begins. We will ask all our Managers to read the 2018 Little League Rule Book so that they are clear on the various rules that will govern McIntire Little League. There are additional training resources available should you be interested but a thorough understanding of the Little League Rule Book is a necessity for all Majors managers.

Some of the questions in this application may seem harsh but it is all in the best interest of the children. This application is confidential and will be reviewed by the managers' selection committee of McIntire Little League to select the most suitable managers. Our highest priority is the well being of the children entrusted to our care.
