## **Post Season Letter of Commitment**

Dyer Little League is preparing to select players for its post season tournament All-Star and T.O.C. teams. In order to be selected, all players must complete and return this Post Season Letter of Commitment by May 25<sup>th</sup>. District Teams will be announced on June 8<sup>th</sup>.

The DLL post season teams will play in the District 2 post season tournaments. The time commitment for the All-Star team is considerable, with practice every day, and sometimes twice a day, during the weeks leading up to the tournament. **All Star players are expected to be in town and available for all practices and games during this time.** If you know your child will be unavailable at any time in June or July you must disclose the dates on the back of this form. **The commitment to the All-Star teams will start June 7<sup>th</sup> and last until the team is eliminated from tournament play, or plays its final tournament in possibly late July or early August. T.O.C. teams will start June 9<sup>th</sup> and last until the team plays their last tournament game, normally the first week of July.**

An All-Star team could advance and play several hours from home and require hotel rooms, travel, etc. A uniform fee of **\$100.00** per player will be assessed by the League to help cover the cost of the uniform. This fee WILL NOT cover all of your child's expenses. You may be asked to pay additional money to cover additional expenses. All teams are responsible for their own expenses as they are not paid by the league. Most T.O.C. fees will be picked up by the league. If DLL hosts a tournament, a refundable \$50 check will be turned in to your manager. It will be returned once you work one concession stand or other shift during the tournament. It will be cashed if you do not.

Playing time WILL NOT be equal, and your child may NOT play every inning or the same position that he/she played during the regular season. Minimum play rules vary from tourney to tourney. See LLI rules online for details. Playing time and position assignments are at the sole discretion of the Manager.

### **How are All-Star Managers chosen?**

The Board will select the Managers for all All-Star teams. The Manager will then choose his (2) allowed coaches. All coaches must be board approved.

### **How are All- Stars selected?**

Voted on by Major Division managers, players and coaches.

### **How are T.O.C. Managers chosen?**

The Board will select the Managers for all T.O.C. teams. The Managers will then choose his (2) allowed coaches. All coaches must be board approved.

### **How are T.O.C.s selected?**

All players who request to play T.O.C.s will be placed on a team.
