## **U12-U18 Academy Curriculum Overview**

Participation with the Parsippany Soccer Club Academy program includes the following:

- All training and game day coaching conducted by professional trainer(s)
- Play in appropriate division of the EDP League
- Tournaments annually:
  - o **U12**: 5 tournaments
  - O **U13-U18**: 6-7 tournaments (as schedule allows)
- NJ Cup participation
- Team Training Sessions:
  - o Fall:
    - U12-U14: 2-3 times per week (as schedule allows)
    - **U15-U18**: starting in the Fall the teams will train once a week until HS season ends, then 2-3 times per week
  - O Winter: U12-U18 2 times per week
  - O Speed and Strength Training: U12-U18 once per week during winter
  - O Spring/summer: U12-U18 2-3 times per week (as schedule allows)
- Goalkeeper Training
- Additional practices as set by the Director of Coaching (Chris Brauchle) and Technical Director (Stan Matlak)

**Annual Fee:** The annual fee for the Academy program includes everything listed above, plus all administration fees (Club registration league, ref fees, passes, etc.). It does not include fees for any additional tournaments, the uniform kits, additional equipment, specialized training, or cost to transport a player to/from practices or games. The fees are as follows:

## Non-Resident Fee: \$100 per player

By ordinance, the Township of Parsippany-Troy Hills assesses a \$100 fee to all non-resident participants for facility use and maintenance. This fee is billed separately.

**Uniform Kit:** Parsippany SC Academy teams wear Adidas uniform kits for both home and away games as well as for training. The official FC Bayern Munich affiliation kit must be purchased annually by all Academy players and is one of the game day kits. The PSC uniform (white kit) is the other game day kit. Neither uniform kit is included in the fee and will need to be purchased separately. Players are responsible to keep all uniform and training gear in good shape or will be required to purchase new ones. Details on how to order the both uniform kits will be provided after acceptance; payment is extra and due at time of purchase. The uniform kits are: the FC Bayern Munich affiliation kit which contains official FC Bayern jersey and shorts plus game socks; the PSC kit which contains white jersey, white shorts, white socks, plus blue training shorts and socks. The Parsippany Soccer Club may designate other pieces as required for the Academy player.





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**Payment Schedule:** the below payment schedule is to be followed unless approval for an alternate payment plan has been given by the VP of Travel. Failure to maintain your account in good standing may result in player being restricted from practice and games until it is brought up to date.

• **Upon Acceptance**: \$600 (\$700 for non-residents)

• U12-U14:

✓ 1st Payment: 33% of balance due on or before August 15, 2018

✓ 2nd Payment: 33% of balance due on or before October 1, 2018

✓ 3rd Payment: 33% of balance due on or before November 15, 2018

• U15-U18:

✓ 1<sup>st</sup> Payment: 33% of balance due *on or before October 30*, 2018

✓ 2<sup>nd</sup> Payment: 33% of balance due *on or before November 30*, 2018

✓ 3<sup>rd</sup> Payment: 33% of balance due on or before January 30, 2019

Please note: by accepting the position you understand that this is a year-long commitment. You are expected to attend and participate in ALL training sessions, matches and tournaments as set forth in the program plus any additional events chosen by the team's coach in conjunction with the Director of Coaching and Technical Directors. You acceptance of this offer also signifies you are fully accepting the financial obligation. Your commitment also includes volunteering at the Parsippany Pride Tournament and Parsippany Soccer Club sponsored events where parent involvement is needed; otherwise player may be restricted from playing. As a non-profit club, Parsippany Soccer Club develops its Club, Premier, and Academy budgets based on total number of participants in each program and assuming revenues equals costs. As a result, no refunds will be granted and any surplus at the end of each fiscal year will be applied to the Club's Travel Enhancement Fund.
