Code of Conduct for Coaches

Coaches should conduct themselves in a appropriate manner at all times, and should foster an environment that promotes sportsmanship, teamwork, commitment and hard work. The following guidelines have been established by the NEYSA Executive Board as a guideline for the conduct of coaches in their role as a leader of our youth and should be adhered to at all times during both games and practice.

Required Conduct of Coaches:

- There should be no physical contact with a player, other than that necessary to demonstrate a drill or particular position. Never touch a player when angry.
- Never put yourself in a position in which you are alone with a player and there are no other persons present.
- Foster a positive environment for your players and offer encouragement. Never berate a player in public or private.
- Stress and foster an environment of "team first".
- Be organized and adequately prepare for all practices and games.
- Establish and maintain a reliable means of communication with parents to ensure information is communicated accurately and timely.
- Set parameters for your players and ensure they conduct themselves within them.
- Respect each and every team's coaches, players and parents at all times.
- Respect game officials or referees at all times.
- Never use profane, foul or negative language at any time during practice, games, or in the presence of your players.
- Never use tobacco, alcohol, or any illegal substance at any time during practice, games, or in the presence of your players.
- Contact information of parents and players should be kept confidential and not distributed to the entire team or used for other than official team business.
- All parental complaints and/or disagreements should be handled privately and reported to the General Manager in accordance with the NEYSA By-Laws, Article VIII, Section 7 – Complaint Process.

Any violation of this Code of Conduct will result in disciplinary action as set forth in the NEYSA By-Laws, Article XIII – Discipline.

Acknowledgement:
