

STATEMENT OF PRECAUTION

Under the guidance of the Mayor of Melrose, the Board of Health, and the Melrose Park Commission, the City of Melrose prioritizes the importance of proper health and safety precautions involving indoor group gatherings for all programming. We strictly follow all guidelines established by the State of Massachusetts in order to ensure the safety of our participants and their families. Our goal is for Melrose residents to have the opportunity to return to the activities they enjoy, while adhering to all necessary precautions.

Mandatory Participation Guidelines

Participants are required to follow the outlined guidelines at all times. Participants that do not adhere to these mandatory guidelines will be removed from the program to ensure the safety of all.

- Social distancing (6 – 12 feet) as much as possible
- Masks must be worn at all times
- Mandatory attendance
- Must be pre-registered online
- Bring your own water with your name on it
- No spectators allowed (rolling drop off)
- No congregating before or after program
- Sanitation stations available
- Participants may be screened
- Please do not arrive more than 5 minutes prior to the start of program
- If displaying symptoms, DO NOT ATTEND!
- Anyone that does not comply with the guidelines above may be asked to leave the program/facility
