

BROOKVILLE SOCCER ASSOCIATION CODE OF CONDUCT

Parents are an integral part of the Brookville community. As such, parents' behavior on the sideline and support of their child is of the utmost importance. This waiver outlines what is expected of parents to create a positive environment for all players. Parents MUST review the following guidelines and agree before their child will be allowed to play.

- 1. Display appropriate behavior on the sidelines at all times.
- 2. Encourage players with cheers and positive comments only.
- 3. Demonstrate good sportsmanship.
- 4. Never speak to the referee.
- 5. Only speak to opposing parents in a complimentary fashion, or if you know them personally. No matter their behavior, how the other team or coach acts, you be the better person.
- 6. Do not speak negatively about or to any player or coach while on the sideline. Remember, they are kids and volunteer coaches.
- 7. Please refrain from coaching or giving instructions to players on the field. This applies to your own child as well as other players on the team.
- 8. Have players at practice and games on time.
- 9. Notify the coach in advance if a player cannot attend a scheduled practice or game.
- 10. Be on time to pick up players and stay tuned in the case of inclement weather.
- 11. Focus on effort and development not on winning.
- 12. Communicate with coaches if there are questions or concern, but NOT during, before or after the games.
- 13. You are responsible to ensure that all family members and guests you bring to games are aware of the codes of conduct.

Inappropriate behavior will lead to suspension of a parent from all Brookville Soccer activities.
