The Lombard Baseball League, announces the 2017 *Lombard Baseball League Scholarship & Awards Program.* Under the Program, two (2) \$1,000 scholarships will be awarded to seniors in high school or students currently in college or technical school that participated in the LBL in past years.

Program Guidelines & Priorities:

- * Seeking graduating seniors or students in college or technical school with a record of volunteerism in the community in non-school sponsored activities and participation in extracurricular school activities.
- * Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.0, and plan to or attend a 2 or 4 year college or technical school.
- * Applicants must have the endorsement of their Guidance Counselor on their application attesting they are a qualified as fit for this scholarship program.

The applications will be reviewed and recipients selected by a committee consisting of volunteers from the LBL. The scholarships will be awarded in June 2017.
