Recreational Coach's Agreement

(I) Eligibility of the Head/Assistant Coach

- Must have completed background check
- Must have completed the *SafeSport training* course
- Must have completed the *Heads Up Concussion* course
- Must be available on scheduled practice night(s) and game days

(II) Responsibilities of the Head/Assistant Coach

- Must teach the players sportsmanship and to the best of his/her knowledge the basic skills of soccer
- Should be prepared to attend any Club instructional programs set up by the Board such as Coaches' Clinics, Coaches' Meetings and/or Parent Meetings
- Must attend practices and games
- Shall be responsible for the conduct of the players of his/her team at games
- At the end of each season, each coach will rate all players on his/her team. Ratings shall be turned into the Director of Coaching.
- The coach is responsible for keeping the team parents & players updated with all practice, game, field or time changes
- Must notify the parents and players of scheduled team/individual picture times
- All players must play at least 50% of the game
- The coach shall honor the spirit of sportsmanship and not allow the score of the game to exceed a 6 goal lead
- The coach and parents are not allowed to question or yell at the referee (they are teenagers)
- Must be aware of the location of a first aid kit and ice in the event of an injury
