

HEALTH AND SAFETY REMINDERS:

Player Health & Safety remains our priority. Please take a moment to review the following health related information to protect our players:

- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash.
