PARENT CODE OF CONDUCT

As a proud parent of a player in the Twin City Youth Soccer Association, I agree to the following:

I will pay my assessments and other team-related fees to the team's treasurer and the Association on time. I understand that failing to do so may result in making my child ineligible to participate in all TCYSA-related events, and may prevent my child from taking part in any program offered by NCYSA or any other of its member associations.

I will always remember my child plays soccer for his or her benefit, not mine.

I will not coach or instruct the players on or off the field. I understand that doing so may be counterproductive to what the coach intends and that such coaching may also confuse the players.

I will not argue with or complain about a referee's call or decision, even if the referee makes a mistake. I will not approach a referee at any time before, during, or after a game.

I will encourage my child to abide by the laws of the game and maintain a high level of sportsmanship.

I will support the decisions our coaches make and in doing so support the team. I will not interrupt a coach immediately prior to, during or after a practice or game. I will discuss these issues privately and discreetly at an appointed time agreed upon with the coach. If this does not result in a satisfactory outcome, I will contact the Director of Coaching.

I will not discuss issues concerning my child or other players with other parents.

I will always remember that children learn best by examples that are set for them.

I will make sure that my child arrives on time for all games, practices and any other soccer functions according to the times set by the coaching staff.

I will focus on my child's development as a player and a person rather than just winning soccer games. I will offer praise to my child for playing his or her best regardless of the outcome of a game.

I will inform the coach of any injury or illness that may negatively affect the safety of my child or compromise his or her teammates.

I will work with my child's team manager to ensure that all administrative tasks requested of my child and our family are handled in a timely manner.

Mine and my child's commitment to his or her team and to TCYSA is for the duration of the upcoming soccer season.

I understand that if I break rules, especially in the case of referees or team dynamics, I may be disciplined by Twin City Youth Soccer Association which can result in the suspension of my attendance at TCYSA events involving my child, and/or be subject to action by the North Carolina Youth Soccer Association's Discipline and Appeals.
