Out of Town Travel Guidelines

Fusion Out-of-Town Team Travel Guidelines

The following are the guidelines (rules) that every player must follow in regards to out of town tournaments. Failure to follow the guidelines set forth could result in dismissal from the trip and club.

EQUIPMENT

All players must wear the club issued adidas game uniform equipment to be eligible to play. No alternate socks or shorts allowed. Also, for warm ups, players may only wear their 2014 Fusion Training Shirt. If the weather is cool, Fusion Warm Up (zip up top) is the only acceptable outer apparel. Jersey colors for each game will be determined at the hotel before departure.

MEALS

Ultimately, players will be responsible for proper nutrition during the event. All players are required to attend team meals unless given permission otherwise from staff.

Out-of-Town Tournaments

- Teams will be traveling from the hotel to the fields together.
- Players must be dressed uniformly when departing to the games.
- Using the swimming pool, Jacuzzi, exercise equipment, or the like must only be done with permission of the coach.
- Players must follow the itinerary and must follow curfew precisely.
- Every person associated with the Fusions' Club must follow the rules of the hotel in which they are staying.
- Players should not engage in excessive horseplay, play soccer in the hotel hallways, or go barefoot within the hotel
- Players will not be permitted to leave hotel grounds unless approved by Fusion staff
- Players are not permitted to have members of the opposite sex in their rooms at anytime.
- Players are will not be permitted to travel home from event with another parent unless approved in writing from said players parents.
- All players / parents must have read and signed the NC Fusion Assumption of Risk Form to be permitted to travel with the club out of town. This form can be found at www.ncfusion.com under policies and forms.
- All ECNL and DA players are required to travel on group trips with team (bus/plane) unless given permission from staff.
- NC Fusion will have coaches and chaperones on hand. However, there are many more players than adult coaches and chaperones, therefore, it is impossible for every player to be in sight of a chaperone or coach at every waking minute. Therefore, when outside their hotel rooms, players should stick together in groups of 2-4, and obey all hotel rules. Of course, the consumption of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited. Players may not leave the hotel without

the permission of the NC Fusion staff. Players given permission to leave hotel grounds must do so in groups of 2-4, no player is permitted to leave hotel grounds alone.
