

# Piscataway SC 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Fall Classic

## Tournament Check-In Procedures

**There is NO in-person check-in.** Team check-in is ALL ON-LINE, and must be done by September 1<sup>st</sup>. You must do this through your [system.GotSport.com](http://system.GotSport.com) account.

- A. Go to the *Team Management* tab
- B. Select the *Registrations* sub-tab
- C. Select the event *Piscataway SC 42<sup>nd</sup> Annual Fall Classic*
- D. Select the *Registration* tab
- E. Click the *Edit* button
- F. Scroll down and find the buttons to upload the following files:
  - Official 2023-24 NJYS Roster
  - Official 2023-24 NJYS Player & Coach Passes
  - Then scroll down and press *Save*



### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

1. **RULES** – Please make sure you read the rules. If you RUN UP the score, or get a red card, you will lose points, so please read the rules.
2. **PARTICIPATION MEDALS** – We will attempt to deliver your Participation Medals (for U7-U10 teams) at your first game. If we miss you, please stop by the Headquarters tent.
3. **SPORTSMANSHIP AWARDS** – We expect the highest level of sportsmanship to be displayed by all participants. To emphasize this goal, each team will receive 4 Fall Classic Sportsmanship Awards. At the end of each game you, the coach, should give this award to a player on YOUR team that showed the best sportsmanship.

Referees will provide coaches with a Sportsmanship Award tag at each game.

These awards should not necessarily be given to the best player on the team. Kids learn the basics of sportsmanship from the adults in their lives, especially their parents and their coaches. Kids who see adults behaving in a sportsmanlike way gradually come to understand that the real winners in sports are those who know how to persevere and to behave with dignity - whether they win or lose a game.

We expect the coaches and parents to be role models for the players. Please share this with your parents. Teams, coaches and parents that do not show proper sportsmanship will not be allowed to return.

4. **GAME TIMES** – All Games will start on the hour, every hour! If you or your opponent are not ready, the Referees will still start the game clock. Each game will end no later than 5 minutes before each hour. Have your players at the field 15 minutes before each game.
5. **AT THE FIELD** – We want ALL players, parents and coaches of the same team to occupy the same side of the field. Check your game schedule if you are the “home” or “away” team, and occupy the **correct side of the field**.
6. **PATCH EXCHANGE** – Exchange of Club Patches after every game is highly encouraged.
