

Green Valley Little League Walk-Up Music Policy

Green Valley Little League (GVLL) is excited to allow walk-up music to enhance the player experience and create a fun, energetic atmosphere at our fields. To ensure appropriateness and smooth game operations, the following guidelines must be followed:

1. Eligibility

- Walk-up music is permitted for **T-ball division and above**.
- Use of walk-up music is optional.

2. Song Selection

- All music must be **family-friendly and appropriate** for a youth sporting event.
- **No explicit, inappropriate, or suggestive lyrics** are permitted.
- Songs containing profanity (even if edited), sexual content, references to drugs/alcohol, violence, or discriminatory language are not allowed.
- The league reserves the right to deny or remove any song at its discretion.

3. Submission Process

- Players must submit their song choice to their team manager by the designated deadline.
- Only **one song per player**.
- The song clip will be limited to **15–20 seconds**.
- No last-minute or same-day submissions will be accepted.

4. Game Day Operations

- Music will only be played during the player's walk-up and must stop before the first pitch.
- Music must not delay the pace of play.
- Only the designated sound system operator may control music.

5. Sportsmanship & Conduct

- Music may not target, mock, or be used against opposing teams or players.
- Walk-up music is meant to be fun and positive for everyone.

6. Enforcement

- If a song violates policy, it will be immediately removed.
- Repeated violations may result in loss of walk-up music privileges for the player or team.
