5TH & 6TH Grade Jr. Cadet Team Details

- **Evaluations will be held on Oct 5th, 19th, & 23rd at the Intermediate School gym; arrive 6:30-6:45, end 8:55.** Cuts will be made after each date; those not cut MUST attend all remaining dates.
- **Players are expected to attend ALL tryout sessions – not just one.**
- **A short registration process and parents meeting** will occur prior to the beginning of the first evaluation. Please plan to attend, no exceptions!
- There will be two teams chosen to participate in the Lehigh Valley League, a highly competitive league comprised of teams from many of the area school districts. There are no “A” and “B” teams playing in this league, but rather extremely competitive teams from different size school districts, playing in two separate divisions. - Any boy in 5th or 6th grade who lives in the Nazareth Area School District, **and who plans on attending the Nazareth Middle School in 7th grade** is eligible for the team.
- The selection of the team(s) will be based on evaluations conducted by area youth coaches and independent evaluators, including middle and/or high school coaches from Nazareth.
- Each team will consist of 10 players.
- In order to be selected on this team, the player and parents must be committed to attend all practices and be prepared to play in more games than the CBL League. In general, these teams will be playing >20 games during the season, as well as playing in a Thanksgiving weekend and Holiday tournament.
- Additional fees, beyond the community organization registration fees, will be required to offset the costs of the extended season, uniforms, and tournaments. Registration fees provided to the community organization will be transferred to the Jr. Cadet program, for those players chosen for the teams.
