Code of Conduct for Coaches/Managers

I pledge to provide positive support, care and encouragement for all children participating in softball by following the Clinton Girls Softball League Code of Conduct for Coaches and Managers.

As a supportive coach or manager:

- I will treat each player as an individual, remembering the emotional and physical development of each participant
- I will do my best to provide a safe playing situation for all players
- I will place the emotional and physical well being of my players ahead of a personal desire to win.
- I will do my best to organize practices that are fun and challenging to all players.
- I will encourage good sportsmanship by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches and umpires at every game or practice.
- I will be knowledgeable in the rules of ASA youth softball as well as the local rules used by the Clinton Girls softball association and will teach those rules to the players.
- I will remember that I am a youth sports coach/manager and that the game is for the children, not the adults.

Consequences: Details of the circumstances warrant different consequences, a warning does not have to be issued prior to probation or banishment

- A verbal warning from CGSA Board and/or a written reprimand for the CGSA file.
- Placement on probation.
- Removal from the program.

*** Remember: the umpire(s) have the right to ask any parent, coach or manager to leave if they are acting in an unsportsmanlike manner.*
