## 2103 Parent/Guardian Code of Conduct

The Beaver County Youth Baseball League (BCYBL) and its member organizations will enforce a zero tolerance stance on parent/fan/child behavior before, during & after all BCYBL events at all locations. We ask that everyone abide by the following:

### **Rules of Conduct:**

--Adults should lead by example and show children that problems can be resolved without loud and abusive behavior. This behavior, as well as violence should not be resorted to as a means of conflict resolution.

--Foul language in the presence of children will not be tolerated at any time by the BCYBL and all member organizations. Also, verbal assaults or demeaning language directed towards coaches or players of any team will not be tolerated.

--Public criticizing of coaches or officials will be discouraged as it impedes our goal of players learning proper respect for them. Abuse of umpires is unacceptable.

### **Penalties:**

Any parent, fan, coach or players who refuse to abide by these rules may be ejected from the game and may be banned from attending future BCYBL events at any location. In some circumstances, children could be removed from the program.
