

Draft Procedure

- All communities will use a snake draft approach. (Examples below)

- A total redraft of all teams, at all levels, will be done on a yearly basis
- All players must be registered and evaluated
- The head coach may select an assistant coach of his choice prior to the draft **IF** agreed upon amongst all opposing coaches.
 - If all coaches are not in agreement on the selection of the assistant coach, then the draft will proceed without an assistant coach being named for that team(s)
 - The head coach's son\daughter, will be automatically on their team and will be placed in their rightful draft position in the coach's opinion approved by all opposing coaches (mitigated by the communities board members if necessary)
 - The chosen assistant coach, if agreed upon by all opposing coaches, will be automatically on that team and will be placed in their rightful draft position in the coach's opinion approved by all opposing coaches (mitigated by the communities board members if necessary)
- The head coach must be at the player evaluation and draft
- After the draft has completed, all coaches must sign that they are in agreement that the draft procedure was followed and agreed upon.
- After each coach has signed, the county representative or President must sign confirming all teams abided by the draft procedure
- Failure to abide by the procedure will result in that communities forfeit of playoff eligibility
