• I will encourage and demonstrate by example the importance of good sportsmanship and positive support for all players, coaches and officials at all practices and games.

• I will place the emotional and physical well-being of my child above my personal desire to win.

• I will assist in maintaining OYTF an Alcohol, Drug, and Smoke free environment.

• I will assist in teaching my child that rules are important and must be followed.

• I will support coaches and officials working with my child, in order to encourage a positive and enjoyable experience for all.

• I understand that verbal and physical abuse is not to be tolerated against anyone in this organization, other organizations we are playing, and referees including profanity and foul language.

• I understand that racial epithets or negative innuendo related to a person/players race, religion or ethnicity will not be tolerated.

• I will show respect for all officials, coaches and volunteers.

• I will not create conflict by slander, malicious rumors or threats, nor will I entice others to do so.

• I will show support in the decision of suspending my child for a game it they are kicked out of a game for any reason.

• I will get my child to every practice or understand that they may miss game time based on amount of unexcused practice time missed during the week.

• I will make sure that my child will always have at least 1 parent/legal guardian at every game.

• I will make sure that my child is picked up promptly at the end of each practice. I understand if not picked up within 30 minutes, my child will be turned over to the police and picked up there.

By agreeing below, I understand that the OYTF had adopted a NO TOLERANCE POLICY. If I violate any of the Code of Ethics it will result in my child's and my/our participation from any OYTF

activity for not less than the balance of the current season, or as determined by the OYTF Executive Board.
