#### 1. Football

# a) BCYFL Report

2 new bylaws proposed last month at the league level. Likely to have a lot of bylaw proposals next month. Vote on bylaws in April. There's talk about the BCYFL becoming part of United Youth Football League. It's a national organization. We would still run the way we do now but at the end of the year, our champion would be able to go to nationals. We don't have to go but we have the opportunity to pursue a national championship.
