III. Committee Reports:

1. Football

a) BCYFL Report

Jeff & Van went to a long meeting about bylaw updates. Next month the BCYFL will vote on bylaw changes. We will have to talk about which changes we support. Last meeting, they picked new divisions. New divisions for league are; Division 1 - Central Valley, Blackhawk, Riverside, Freedom, Rochester, Ambridge & Moon; Division 2 - New Brighton, Beaver Falls, Hopewell, Aliquippa, Ellwood City & Brighton Twp.
