III. Committee Reports:

1. Football

a) BCYFL Report

NSID (National Sports ID) opened live – Kayla is our point person. She will start uploading kids' names, birth certificates, etc. Early in the process of learning how to do this. Gave us a contact at NSID if we have questions. Van – deadline? End of July (28?). Last night, all organizations presented registration numbers. Quaker Valley struggling, New Brighton struggling at Twerps. Freedom will not have a Termite team, players going to Rochester to play there. Even with both, they only have 11 kids. Quaker Valley only has 7 Twerps. All other organizations numbers are great. Schedule – our home games are Saturday's 2-4-630, senior night will be 7:30 for Mighty Mites. Other teams 8/28 Blackhawk, Saturday 12-2-4. Freedom did not have info on game times/day, waiting for school district. 9/19 vs. Moon, Sunday 10-12-2.
