Total expenses to date: \$7,596.97. Total Income to date: \$10,368.89. Profit: \$2,771.92. Norm will settle Bruster's total back to us after their last day here. Projected total expenses for 2021: \$10,400. Total income projections: \$15,000. Estimated profit for 2021 (not including playoffs): \$4,785. 146% mark up. Best selling hot food – french fries.

Inventory: to count what is selling at games is impossible at this point. If we want to keep better track, we need to plan a capital investment of a better register for next year. Point of sale system is around \$600-\$700. We can program the system with all items we sell. Good investment. Wednesday dinners profit roughly \$150-\$200.
