3. Committee Reports:

- a. Football
 - i. BCYFL Report/Updates:
 - 1. General Report: Had BCYFL coaches picnic Jaycen, DJ & Matt were present. Handed in clearances & received schedule. Quinn talked about rules for the coming season:
 - a. A holding penalty or penalty in the backfield will not be a spot foul, instead it will be marked off from the previous spot of the ball.
 - b. TWERPS AND TERMITES ONLY, all punts will have a 15 second clock run off to keep consistency in clock management game to game.
 - c. Visors are not permitted unless they are clear or we have a prescription from a doctor, no exceptions.
 - d. We are not allowed to mic our players

Weights were certified and back in the shed.

The week 7 by week, we could see the Termites and Mighty Mites playing a team from the Grove City league thru the BCYFL. The BCYFL is aiming on bring teams from the north into the BCYFL and possibly expanding the league to 29 teams. Would expand to 3 divisions with 3 Championships. They have a meeting on 7/27 to bring their ideas up to the Shenango League and determine if it is in fact possible and if they would be interested. The Twerps will have a vacancy, unless they were to play Brighton Township at Rochester to fill the void left by Rochester twerps

being absorbed into freedom due to lack of numbers. We will meet with the coaches of the Twerps to gauge interest.

8/5 scrimmage @ Hopewell scrimmage is still good.

2. Other: Player card day is 8/6. Rochelle called. Coaches cards are done, we will get them on player card day.

ii. Organization Report/Updates:

1. General Report: Heat acclimation week is off to a good start. Coaches have been passing the screwdrivers and handpumps around and adjusting the kids helmets.

Jaycen felt the Zack Pagley moment of silence was nice, thanks to Kayla and Jenny for making that happen and to all the coaches for wrangling the kids. Obviously, our deepest sympathy from the Li'l Warriors to the Pagley family thru this difficult time. We're all keeping them in our thoughts and prayers and will help out however we can.

There had been discussion of buying a hi-res camera to benefit all 3 levels for years to come. The camera is Huddle compatible, battery operated and creates and opportunity for coaches to see the entire field to better show the kids how the plays breakdown from a teaching standpoint. This is a huge tool for the kids taking the next step into their football life by learning to watch film and watching their growth from twerps to high school.

The second part of the camera is getting the shed basement done to create an environment to teams to breakdown film with the kids. we will be looking for volunteers to clean/paint/ and get the shed ready to film study. so I'm bringing this up for a purchase.

- a. Camera purchase discussion: Purchasing a camera to film football games was originally brought up at the May 22, 2023 meeting & again with the Executive Board. We needed more info before deciding. Cost is \$2,600. Jaycen will benefit all 3 teams. End zone to end zone 25 ft camera. Hudl compatible. Used as a coaching tool. Battery operated, 10 year warranty. 3 day shipping. Kayla wants shed basement project done if we're investing in this so coaches can watch film with their teams.
 - Jenny: Budget wise: We estimate another 40k in expenses for the year but we're ok to buy it. Budget in Capital Investment category.
 - Davon benefits kids for their whole football career. When they currently film, they film the side view & assume they're in the right hole but this will be able to show whole field. Can zoom in from one end zone to another. Can't see that from the current side view.
 - DJ most parents have Hudl. Some kids won't. If we have a dedicated space to watch film, would be beneficial.
 - Doug benefits the kids whenever they go. Speakers get in the

way when filming from the press box. If an away team doesn't have bleachers, can't get a good view. Would get quality film wherever you go whether parents watch it or not. Could post volunteer hours to run it. Easy to run. Hopefully it lasts 10-15 years.

- Is downloaded on a mini SD card. Be sure we have enough battery.
- Dom if you start at Twerps, it'll stay with them forever for progression.
