 - i. BCYFL Report/Updates: Riverside and Freedom have left BCYFL. Riverside is going to Lawrence County league. Freedom is going to Steel County League. With the loss of these two teams, there will no longer be bye weeks, just an 8-game schedule. Riverside (twerp level) does have the opportunity to join an adjoining program (New Brighton) due to no tackle program option in the league they joined. Seeding for playoff rankings will now be by record and not division. EMTs have to be on the sidelines for all games.
